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INCREASING IN STRENGTH

But Saul increased all the more in strength, and confounded the Jews who dwelt in Damascus, proving that this Jesus is the Christ. Acts 9:22

If a babe in Christ is to grow stronger, he must have the nourishment of God's Word. The Bible supplies us with that which direct revelation and personal information supplied Saul. He later told Timothy that "the sacred writings...are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 3:15). He compared the Scriptures to a tool and challenged the young preacher to learn to use his tool well, to be "a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).

Few suggestions to new Christians are more vital than this: Study, study, study God's Word. Imitate the noble-minded Bereans who "received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily" (Acts 17:11.) Study the Bible on your own. Have a regular time for study; perhaps use a plan of study. Also, take advantage of every opportunity to be taught. As a Christian, you are part of God's family. Faithfully attend classes and worship services with your

brothers and sisters in Christ, and study along with them. Learn to enjoy your spiritual food, feasting upon the Word.

Each Christian should periodically examine himself. Let each ask, "What kind of progress have I made as a Christian?" Paul wrote these sad words to Christians who had not grown spiritually as they should have: "And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but... as to infants in Christ. I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are not yet able" (1 [Corinthians 3:1, 2](#)). It is natural to be born a baby; it is tragic to stay a baby. If our honest examination reveals that we have not properly grown, we should resolve to "grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ" ([Ephesians 4:15](#)).
