Persevering Prayer

How easy it is to become discouraged if we have been praying for something specific and we fail to see our prayers being answered. Questions may begin to fill our hearts. “Did I pray right?” “Are there sins I may need to repent of and confess?” “Is my heart really right with the Lord?” “Why does God not answer my prayers?”

The answer to our questions may be in the simple truth that God’s timetable does not match our own. We live on the limited island of time; God lives in the limitless ocean of eternity. We may think we have been praying a long time, but in God’s sight we have spent little time in prayer.

In our moments of doubting our prayers, we need to remember that Jesus gave a parable to teach that “men always ought to pray and not lose heart” (**Luke 18:1**). Our earnest prayers to God should always be offered in the spirit of “not my will but Yours be done.” When we pray and trust God for His answers, we may not always receive what we ask for, when we want it, but we will learn some great lessons if we “continue steadfastly in prayer” (**Romans 12:12**). When we “pray without ceasing” (**1 Thessalonians 5:17**), we will learn patience as we wait on the Lord

and fully trust Him, especially when we don't understand! May we heed God's warning to not become impatient or discouraged, but to continue in prayer and we will learn that God's delay in answering our prayers may be His way of releasing more of His grace and love into our hearts!
