Jesus replied, "I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. Humans can reproduce only human life, but the Holy Spirit gives birth to spiritual life." — [John 3:5-6 NLT](#)

We are called to be spiritual people — holy, righteous, faithful, and compassionate like our Father in heaven. But our own efforts fail at achieving these spiritual characteristics. We need the power and presence of Almighty God at work in our lives to purify and sustain us in our desire to live to honor our Father. Is it important to meet with the saints? Why are we encouraged to meet with each other, lift each other up?

We are all human, we all commit sins. We want to be forgiven. We can pray for each other. If we stay away from other Christians too long, we can become stale. We then can be in danger of drifting away from God. We need the prayers and encouragement from each other.

James knew that Christians could go astray. He said, *"Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins."* (James 5:19, 10)

Many of the writers instructed us to encourage each other; Peter, Luke, the author of Hebrews, and especially Paul in most of his writings. But, if it had only been mentioned once in the Scriptures, it would still be essential.

"Exhort one another daily...lest any of you be hardened enough through the deceitfulness of sin." (Hebrews 3:13) Missing the encouragement of other saints allows sin to creep in.

"And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:24, 25)
