"The Gift for Those Who Belong"

You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. — [Romans 8:9](#)

Most children around the age of 10 or 11 are still playing with friends, wanting to just be a kid. A few are studious, reading books, even writing poems, but seldom do they write about Jesus. And, especially a child from a home that doesn't attend church. Sandra Walker was taught about Jesus at the age of five by her Aunt Charlotte, who soon passed away. Regardless, she has been motivated by a desire to know about God most of her life. She went to church with friends or neighbors, any way she could. At the age of 11, she wrote the following poem, at a traumatic time in her young life:
