Is God important in your life? As a Christian, studying his Word, we can see how important God is to us. God or God's is mentioned many times in the Scriptures. God is love (1 John 4:16). God will wipe away every tear (Revelations 7:17) for those who obey him. Love comes from God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. "This is love for God: to obey his commands. His commands are not burdensome, for everyone born of God overcomes the world." (1 John 5:3, 4)

How do we obey God? How do we know what to do, what He wants us to do? We must study his Word. We cannot rely on what someone tells us. We can be misled. We all have our own opinions, some are wrong. Peter says in Acts 5:29, "We must obey God rather than men." We cannot use one or two verses, we must study all of them, putting together the same thoughts on each subject. You can study the whole bible for years and still learn something new. I have heard my mother say this many times, "You just never learn it all, you can study every day and still learn something new."

God has commanded us to study his Word. In Romans 11:22, "Consider therefore the kindness and sternness of God: sternness to those who fell, but kindness to you, provided that you continue in his kindness. Otherwise, you also will be cut off." We must study his Word, to be favorable in his sight. "It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God." (Hebrews 10:31)
