What words of assurance came from the inspired pen of **Isaiah (41:10): “Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen you. Yes, I will help you. I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.”**

If you have seen the latest news on TV, you are fully aware that we are living during a time of national meltdown — socially, financially, politically, morally and spiritually. Americans are forgetting the One who has blessed our nation. They are forgetting the One whom we once trusted!
