## "Fruit of the Spirit"

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. — [Galatians 5:22-23 NIV](#)*

Sometimes we misunderstand "fruit of the Spirit" because we say "fruits of the Spirit." This difference seems like such a small thing, but, unfortunately, this small thing can lead us to a dangerously false conclusion. The fruit of the Spirit involves all nine of these qualities. We can't excuse a lack of growth in one area or another as simply not having all the fruits of the Spirit. The Holy Spirit is working to create the character of Jesus in us ([2 Corinthians 3:18](#); see also [Galatians 4:19](#)). He wants to see us growing in each area; we should not excuse ourselves from any one of these qualities of Jesus. I don't know about you, but there are several areas in which I need to grow — but I believe the Spirit is making progress in them. Let's keep encouraging each other to let the Spirit lead us to become more and more like Jesus in every way!

## Lifelines by Patty McAlister

Most of us are familiar with the song our "little ones" sing, Fruit of the Spirit ([Gal. 4:23](#)). The last one is self-control. Do you have self-control? Often, we are good at self-control with our outward motions. What about our inward emotions, our thoughts? Many of the sins that we are commanded not to commit are our thoughts and feelings from our heart; envy, hate, worry, anger, and jealousy. Paul and Peter both tell us that we are to have self-control. The leaders of the church are to have self-control. Young and old are commanded to have self-control. To have this we must control our emotions, our desires, be in charge.

This includes our inward thoughts as well as our outward appearance. This includes our families as well as our friends and acquaintances. Self-control is not an easy thing, we must work at it. Peter tells us not to conform to the evil desires; be self-controlled ([1 Peter 1:13](#)). Paul then tells us in [1 Cor. 7:5](#) that if we lose our self-control Satan will tempt us. Satan is always there, ready when we slip. He would make us believe that self-control is not necessary. He wants the control. Are we going to let him? Absolutely not!

We are commanded to control our actions, our thoughts, and our emotions. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man [Ecclesiastes 12:13](#).
