Who else [besides God] has held the oceans in his hand? Who has measured off the heavens with his fingers? Who else knows the weight of the earth or has weighed the mountains and hills on a scale? Who is able to advise the Spirit of the Lord? Who knows enough to give him advice or teach him?

Isaiah 40:12-13 NLT

"An anxious heart weighs a man down, but a kind word cheers him up." Proverbs 12:25

We all like kinds words. Words of encouragement, sympathy, compliments, or words of love. We hunger for words of kindness; however, we shy away from harsh words. "A Gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger." (Proverbs 15:1) It is very difficult to answer a harsh comment with a gentle word. But we know the results are much better if we can.

We have to be responsible for what we say. We should speak to others as we want to be spoken to. Jesus told the Pharisees, "You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? (Matthew 12:34-35)
