Drawing Closer to God in the Psalms

We all want to draw closer to God, don't we? We want to know God. We want to hear his voice. We want a deep, intimate, and personal relationship with our creator. We want to know that God is with us and leading us into the paths of righteousness. We want to think God's thoughts and know God's ways. We want to be like him. We want to conform our will with God's will. We want a meaningful, nurturing, and purposeful experience with God. We can do this by getting alone with God. Just you and the Word.

We want to know God both corporately (church) and individually (disciples). If we as a church, read the Psalms, pray over them, and meditate on them, then when we come together, we can share how God has worked in our spiritual lives during the week. We are going to practice this corporately by reading through the Psalms. We are not reading the Psalms just for information but for transformation. I'm asking for meditation and prayer over the passages you are reading.

Here are some suggestions that can help you. First and foremost, pray before you read. Take a moment to breathe slowly and pray that God might open the eyes of your heart (Eph. 1:18). Praise and thank God for giving you his word. Second, take your time as you read. Don't read to cover a lot of ground, but read to allow God's word to be absorbed

into you. You may have to read a verse or chapter several times. There is no hurry. Just read to listen. Listen as God speaks through the scriptures. Third, meditate on what you read. Let the Word absorb into you. Think about it, contemplate it, reflect on it, and make application to your life. Look for ways God might be speaking to you personally. Meditate on the love, holiness, power, and character of God. You might at this time want to write down what you're thinking in a journal, although it's not necessary. Finally, when your finished reading and meditating, end in prayer. Thank God for his word and pray about the text you just read.

I look forward to watching you grow as you get alone with God.
