“Outside the Gate”

Heb. 13:12, Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered **outside the gate**. According to the law of Moses, sinners who were condemned to die were put to death **outside the city gate (Lev. 24:23)**. Stephen, the first Christian martyr, was **cast out of the city and stoned (Acts 7:58)**).

Because Jesus was made to be **sin on our behalf (2 Cor. 5:21)**, He had to drink the cup of God's wrath **outside the gate**. In view of Jesus' suffering outside the gate, the author exhorts: **Therefore, let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach (Heb. 13:13)**. For a Jew to become a Christian he had to abandon all of the practices of the old law of Moses and be willing to “bear His reproach”. This was far from being an “easy” task!

Jesus made it clear that to follow Him, we must also be willing to **deny ourselves and take up our crosses daily (Lk. 9:23)**. To count ourselves “**crucified with Christ (Rom. 6:11)**” is far from “easy”, but all Christians must bear His shame by daily living under the shadow of His cross outside the camp. The “converted Saul of Tarsus” willingly bore Christ's reproach as he said: **God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me and I to the world (Gal. 6:14)**.

In the minds of first century Jews, the cross was repulsive and represented shame, guilt and reproach that were unworthy to grace the holy city of Jerusalem. Therefore, the condemned sinner was to be taken outside the gate and crucified on Golgotha (**the place of a Skull, Jn. 19:17**). On His cross Jesus bore our sins, which not only included separation from the holy city of Jerusalem, but a historical three hours of excruciating spiritual separation from His holy Father in heaven (**Mk. 15:33-34**).

The message for 21st century Christians is that we must also be willing to bear the shame and reproach of being crucified with Christ that we might not be forced to bear the eternal shame of the separation of our souls and spirits from our Father and His Son! By simple faith in His death, we choose to share Jesus' shame in this life that we might enjoy an eternal life in His holy presence in the heavenly city of Jerusalem!
