## The Soul as the Fingerprint of the Spirit

During a Bible study in the local county jail, I once asked the inmates how they would define “soul”. One young man amazed me with his unique definition that the soul is “the fingerprint of the spirit”. I am amazed that my jail ministry has located many precious souls who have good hearts and are open to Bible studies, but are presently incarcerated by the mistakes they have made in the past. The young man’s definition of “soul” deserves some serious soul searching.

The human soul was created when God’s “Spirit-breath” entered Adam’s physical body and he miraculously became a living soul (**Gen. 2:7**). The Greek word for soul is “psuche”, the word from which we get “psyche”. Our psyche consists of the inner man of the “mind, emotion and will”. From this definition, we conclude that our souls reflect our unique personalities which are the sum total of our thoughts, emotions, choices and experiences in life. In this sense of the word, our souls are “the fingerprint of our eternal spirit”.

Just as physical fingerprints are all different, the same is true of souls. On Judgment Day, God will examine the evidence of our unique spiritual fingerprints. Will the eternal fingerprints of our souls be found upon the pages of the Word of God where we have spent much time reading, studying, and memorizing His words of truth?

Will the fingerprints of our souls be on the palm of Jesus as evidence of our walk of faith with Him?

Or will our fingerprints be found all over the world of sin and the things of the flesh? Just as the criminal's guilt or innocence may be determined by his unique fingerprints, the fingerprints of our souls will ultimately prove whether we were slaves of righteousness or slaves of sin (**Rom. 6:17-18**).

The question which will determine our eternity will be: Did we sow to the spirit or did we sow to the flesh? Did we live for the things which are seen (the flesh), or the things which are not seen (the spirit)? Did we choose to love the world and the carnal things of the world, or did we choose to love Jesus and the eternal things of the spirit? Where are the fingerprints of our souls found today?
