*No wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light--2 Corinthians 11:15*

An illusionist is a person who makes something appear to be real or true but in reality, is quite different from what it seems to be. Satan is the world's greatest illusionist! He is an expert in using the triple temptations of fleshly desires, pride of life and lust of the eyes making them appear to be what they are not (1 John 2:15-17). Understand this. Satan has access to us every waking moment and he knows our strengths as well as our weaknesses. He is our enemy!
