Answer Me When I Call

***Psalms 4:1** "Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress: be gracious to me and hear my prayer" (NASB)*

As we make our journey through this life with all of its trouble and strife, we desperately need the love, mercy and compassion of our God to surround us each step of the way. We are weak, frail human beings and as one of our grand old songs proclaims it so well: "I need thee every hour, most gracious Lord; no tender voice like thine can peace afford. I need thee; Every hour I need thee".
