*[Jesus said,] "When the Friend I plan to send you from the Father comes — the Spirit of Truth issuing from the Father — he will confirm everything about me." — [John 15:26](#)*

I have always been amazed at how Jesus uses the last few hours of his life to prepare his followers for their ordeal as he faces the cross, their wonder in his resurrection, and their amazement at his ascension. There is so much happening in a relatively short time, and it is so unexpected. The disciples are eyewitnesses, but how will they remember it all? How can they be confident in what they do remember? Jesus makes it clear that there is one ultimate answer to these questions: The Friend he will send from the Father, the Spirit of Truth! The Spirit will guide and confirm their message as well as empower them to share it boldly. And as we personally pass through the events of the crucifixion, burial, and resurrection of Jesus in our own baptism, we are given this same Spirit of Truth to help guide us into this same truth they proclaim. The Holy Spirit is our connection to the Source of the story, the truth of the story, and the power of the story of Jesus. No wonder Jesus taught that we have to be "born of water and the Spirit" ([John 3:3-37](#))!

Is it a trait of human nature to doubt? Although we have faith and trust in God and His word, we still have moments of uncertainty. So, why do we have these doubts? It's a fear of the unknown.

We know the apostles had doubts. Even having observed the many miracles performed by Jesus, they had doubts. They were there when Jesus fed the five thousand. They even helped gather the twelve baskets of leftovers. Why did they doubt when later He wanted to feed the four thousand?

Remember Peter, when he wanted to walk on the water to meet Jesus. He became afraid and began to sink. Jesus caught him, saying, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?" When they climbed into the boat, some of them said, "Truly You are the Son of God."

They were humans, just as we are today. They had seen so much but had just come to the conclusion that He truly was the Son of God. It takes us awhile, too.

We also read about Thomas. We call him, Doubting Thomas. He didn't believe Jesus had risen from the grave until he saw the marks on His hands and side. Although he doubted, we also know Thomas for his devotion and courage. Previously, he had been willing to die with Jesus.

For he tells them,

For these two years the famine has been in the land, and there are still five years which there will be neither plowing nor harvesting. And God sent me before you to preserve a posterity for you in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance." (Genesis 45:5-7)
