Lifelines for Ladies by Patty McAlister

Often we have heard, "don't pray for patience because something could happen to try your patience." But, does God really answer our prayers like this? We do know that patience grows from adversities, trials and tribulations. We have experienced this first hand.

Jesus tells us to keep asking, seeking and knocking. "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks, it will be opened." (Matthew 7:7-8) God answers our prayers, we know this, but He doesn't always use our reasoning. He sees the "big picture." Most of the time we don't know what is best for us.

What I said before, about does God really answer our prayers like this, notice the following verses. This is also Jesus speaking to the multitude. "Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to them who ask Him!" (Matthew 7:9-11) So yes, I believe we can safely pray for patience. The degree to which we reach patience may depend on us. If we are stubborn, it may take a harsh lesson to get our attention! God will use what is necessary and helpful to answer our prayers. Besides, experience is the best teacher.

The Bible also says to pray without ceasing, pray for ourselves and to pray for others. If we actually believed God would answer our prayers with a harsh lesson each time, we might stop praying altogether.

We are blessed if we endure temptation, but we are not tempted by God. "Let no one say, when he is tempted, 'I am tempted by God,' for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He himself tempt anyone." (James 1:13) We are tempted by evil, even tempted by the devil. But, God does offer a way to endure and overcome these temptations. (1 Corinthians 10:13)
