CLOTHED IN GODLY GARMENTS

For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. Galatians 3:27

Does this look all right? Do these go together or do they clash? Does this made me look fat? These are the kinds of questions I ask Sherry every Sunday morning before going to the assembly of God’s people. Clothing, being properly dressed is a very important part of our lives. A good portion of the floor space in any shopping center is dedicated to clothing. Consider the large sums of money spent on advertisements so we can be ever aware of the new styles coming out. We have closets and dressers that are full of clothing. In fact, most of us have so much clothing, that we don’t know what to do with it all. So, what do we conclude from all of this about our use of clothing? Obviously, it’s more than protection from the elements, it’s more than just looking good. In short, we use clothing to maintain a better “image” of ourselves.

Spiritually speaking all us have stood before God naked and ashamed in our sins. But then God does for us, what we could not do ourselves. He offers us exactly what we need. Listen to what the prophet Isaiah says; *“I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, And as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.” (Isaiah 61:10)* When an individual answers the gospel call,

responding in faith, obedient faith, submissive faith, coming in repentance, having that change of heart from unbelief to belief, repenting of the sin they have committed in godly sorrow, these garments become available. Being baptized into Christ having their sins washed away (**Acts 22:16**), rising up to walk in a newness of life (**Romans 6:4**), and being clothed in Christ Jesus (**Galatians 3:27**), now they are clothed in godly garments.

These are the garments of salvation that only God can give. As Isaiah said; *"He has clothed me in garments of salvation."* The forgiveness of our sins and hope of eternal life is found in Christ Jesus. It was Jesus who said; *"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."* (**John 14:6**) Speaking of Jesus, Peter and John said; *"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."* (**Acts 4:12**) This salvation that is found in Jesus is full and complete forgiveness. An assurance that God will remember our sins no more, that they will not be held against us in that Day of Judgment. A salvation that is so complete, that no one will bring charge against God's elect.

To be covered with the robe of righteousness of our own, as if we had any, for our acts of righteousness are as filthy rags before Him. (**Isaiah 64:6**) Being clothed in Christ Jesus, His righteousness has been imputed upon us. (**Romans 4:23-35**) To be right before God, this is now our motivation to live right, *to pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.* (**2 Timothy 2:22**)

What a delight it is to wear the garments of salvation and the robe of righteousness. I can be assured that I will live in eternity with my Savior. (**1 John 5:13**) Are you clothed in the godly garments that only God in Christ Jesus can dress you in?
