## Camp Caudle Summer 2015 Review

Another summer has come and gone here at Camp Caudle. It always amazes me how quickly they seem to roll by.

This year we hosted 8 camps. Our Day Camp is for those who have just finished K-6<sup>th</sup> grades. We had three Junior weeks for those who have just finished 2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade. There were two Teen weeks for teens from 7<sup>th</sup> grade through high school graduates. This year we added a week for children of incarcerated parents (Agape). This is the second year to have a week for children in foster care (Least of These).

I've told many people lately that our summer is like Thanksgiving dinner. At the end of May each year we had better have the turkey and dressing ready to sit on the table as our whirlwind summer begins.

We don't get much work done during the summer as the guests are here and it is our time to pass the gravy and

serve the potatoes. We share in the meal with hundreds of

people and now that it is over we have been and will continue to "do the dishes."

Those hundreds of children came from Arkansas, Tennessee, Texas and Oklahoma to spend a week surrounded by loving Christian adults who shared the gospel of Jesus Christ with them. I am grateful to report that many teens were baptized into Christ and an even greater number left with strengthened faith.

As I look at the world we live in, I thank God that he has allowed us such a great platform to minister to these kids and teens. The Lord knows that they need all the strength and encouragement they can get.

Additionally, this summer we had Paula Spitler as our summer nurse, Heather Sutherlin as our cook, and eleven interns. Running a summer program with these guys and Brent is a lot more efficient (and easier) than by myself as it was when I first began the work at Camp Caudle 7 years ago.

I am so thankful for all of your support of Camp Caudle since the beginning almost 24

years ago. Just think of the over 10,000 lives you have impacted and the hundreds of baptisms!

The majority of the weekends through the end of the year are booked with retreats and factoring in the holidays, we are looking at approximately 180 days to repair, renovate and build new. That's not a lot of time. We have added a young man named Zac Smith for the fall to help with the work load.

Also, we are currently working on a master plan for camp. God has truly blessed the work out here. I am excited for what the future holds and thankful that the Dover church of Christ is a part of it.

# Lines for Ladies

“Humility is not thinking less of oneself than one ought. It is not thinking of oneself at all.” Andrew Murray

Not thinking of oneself at all reminds us of Jesus. He suffered so much for us. He knew He would suffer before it was all over. Yet, He did God’s will. He humbled Himself and became our sacrifice, sinful though we were. We know we do not deserve it, but He must not have felt that way. He did it for us, regardless. Besides the pain, He suffered humiliation for us.

Often it is difficult to be humble. We know we should, but it is still hard. “For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted” (Matt. 23:12). We may not be guilty of exalting ourselves above others, but we still fail to humble ourselves as we should.

What does it mean to be humble? There are many definitions for humble. In the Scriptures it is the opposite of being proud or arrogant. Not thinking more highly of oneself than of others is one definition. Other are being meek, gentle, or unpretentious. “He mocks proud mockers but gives grace to the humble” (Prov. 3:34). Grace is given to the humble. That is a good incentive.

Jesus said we must become as little children. “Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven” (Matt. 18:4). Unpretentious, meek, gentle; these all sound like little children. Can we become as a little child in our thinking?

Other definitions of humble are being lowly in nature, poor, modest, ordinary or of an undistinguished nature. This is not what God meant in Scriptures. Jesus was in no way undistinguished. He did come as a modest, poor man. He was never ordinary. He was the Son of God! Some of the Jews may have thought Him ordinary. Those who didn’t recognize Him as the Messiah surely thought so. He is still our best example of humility!
