A Word of Encouragement

*And I will say to my soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink and be merry. But God said to him, thou foolish man, this night is thy soul required of thee--**Luke 12:19-20***

Recorded in this passage from **Luke 12** is the reaction of a certain rich man whose land had produced a remarkably abundant harvest of crops. This man had some great plans for tomorrow but he failed to realize that God controls tomorrow, not man. In a single moment of time all of his plans will be gone. He is going to die, leave all he has on this earth and go out into eternity to meet God unprepared.

I sometimes find myself wondering if we really realize how quickly our lives can change. We talk about it but somehow, we don't really think about it as we live in a world of "I intend" and proceed to go about planning not only one day but days to come as if we have some kind of guarantee that all is going to be well. What man or woman among us has not thought "before I die, I am going to....."? O, how often do we say "tomorrow I am going to go

here or there, tomorrow I am going to do this or that, then tomorrow comes and we say, "it won't hurt to wait another day" and that cycle just goes on and on (**Ecclesiastes 9:10**). Yesterday is history, today is all we have, tomorrow belongs only to God.

It is later than we may think, so while we still have the opportunity, let's express our love for our family, friends, each other and our Lord. Be happy, enjoy life but remember that this earthly life is so fragile and we all walk a fine line between living and dying (**1 Sam. 20:3**). Remember to keep God in all our plans (**Proverbs 27:1; James 4:13-15**). If God is not a constant part of our plans, we will find ourselves wishing for, wanting and hoping for that which will cost us our souls. Remember, tomorrow we may be incapable of doing or saying the things we want and need to say and do. Remember, we may have no tomorrow left (**James 4:14**). Remember judgment is coming, prepare for it (**Acts 17:30-31; 2 Cor. 5:10**). Remember, tomorrow may be too late!
