"Speaking Boldly"

[The disciples praying after Peter and John were released from jail:] "Now, Lord, ... enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly. — [Acts 4:29-31 NIV](#)

The early followers of Jesus were facing harsh opposition from the very folks who had Jesus crucified. Rather than complaining about or fearing this opposition, the believers confessed the greatness of God and asked for the strength to boldly proclaim the message of Jesus. In response to their prayer, the place where they were meeting was shaken, and they were all empowered by the Spirit to speak the word of God with boldness. Shouldn't this also be our prayer in a culture that is growing more and more hostile to God? Why not pray for the power of the Holy Spirit so you can boldly proclaim Jesus, treating people with gentleness and respect (cf. [1 Peter 3:15](#)).

*“And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last. Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. So, when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God!” **Mark 15:37-39***

We are not told what happened about the centurion, but have you ever wondered about him? Did he become one of the followers of Christ? Did he make this comment and then later forget about Jesus? The centurion made a great confession. He surely must have been frightened about what he had just been a part of. We don't really know.

The centurion could have become a believer of Christ or he could have continued as he was before. Hopefully, the centurion truly believed and searched for someone to tell him what he needed to do to be forgiven.

We have the same option today. How many of us believe that Jesus is truly the Son of God, but do nothing about it? We can be in danger of crucifying Him again. (Read **Hebrews 6:4-6**) We wouldn't do it intentionally, but it could happen. It could be a gradual thing, slipping up on us if we get lax in our efforts.
