## The Good Samaritan and Evangelism

Jesus taught the parable of the Good Samaritan who lived his life by the most unselfish philosophy possible. Though Jesus was not a Samaritan, He certainly practiced the philosophy of being the only perfect “Good Samaritan” as He denied Himself that He might reach out to the urgent and eternal needs of all lost sinners. The Good Samaritan of Jesus’ parable reached out to a suffering and dying man to rescue him from physical death. Jesus and His disciples reached out to meet the spiritual needs of dying sinners. Evangelism is the most important way that God’s people today can become “good Samaritans” to those who are lost in sin. We must go out of our way to help bind up the spiritual wounds of those who are lost and are dying an eternal death of separation from their Creator-God in heaven. The church of our Lord is challenged to become the most unselfish, loving and caring group of people upon this earth as we pattern our lives after that of our Lord.

To become “spiritual Good Samaritans” we must be willing to be out the funds needed to care for sharing the gospel with dying sinners. The unselfish philosophy of the Good Samaritan was: “What is mine is yours, if you

need it.” With the spirit of true stewardship, the Good Samaritan recognized that all things belong to God (**Psa. 24:1**) and was willing to use his time, his talents, his efforts and his money in a way that would honor the God who gave him those gifts. There was no doubt in the Good Samaritan’s mind what God wanted him to do when he came upon a pitiful, abused and dying man. The Good Samaritan simply did what God would have done. **For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son . . . John 3:16**). The Good Samaritan did what Jesus did who emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant . . . humbled Himself, becoming obedient, even to death on the cross (**Phil. 2:7-8**).

The Good Samaritan believed in practicing the Golden Rule in his life. **Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them. . . (Matt. 7:12)**. Today, the example of the Good Samaritan rises from the inspired word of God to challenge each of us to be unselfishly concerned about the physical and spiritual needs of others. Paul wrote in **Phil. 2:4** that we should not just look out for our own interests but for the interests of others as well. We are to have this attitude of Jesus toward others. Jesus makes it clear that those who will serve others are really serving Him in **Matt. 25:31-46**.
