The Church As The Bride of Christ

Ephesians 5:26-27

Ralph's Refection's - "The Bride of Christ"

Have you ever wondered why Jesus never sought an earthly bride during His 33 years of life as a man? Most men have an ambition to share their lives with a beloved bride. However, Jesus never chose an earthly bride.

Jesus lived His earthly life under the shadow of His cross as He knew He was "born to die for our sins." In view of His pending death on Calvary, He denied Himself of the earthly joy of a loving spouse in favor of the eternal joy of providing the needs of His future bride! Paul said: "Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing by the word, that He might present her to Himself, a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:25-27)

Jesus patiently waited for a glorious and eternal bride (without spot or wrinkle; holy and without blemish). Unlike the marital joining of man and woman as "one flesh", through His Holy Spirit Jesus makes His bride one spirit with Him (1 Cor. 6:16-17). Yes, Jesus longed for a sinless and eternal bride, washed and cleansed of all her sin by the power of His precious blood.

Paul told the Christians in Corinth: "For I have betrothed you to one husband that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ" (2 Cor. 11:2). The Jewish betrothal was similar to an "engagement", but as binding as marriage itself. Joseph and Mary's betrothal could be dissolved only by divorce (Matt. 1:19) or death.

Christ's bride, the church on earth, is now in her "betrothal period." We are "sealed" with the "Holy Spirit of promise" (Eph. 1:13), with God's assurance that the groom is on His way back to receive His faithful bride to Himself. When He comes, we will enter the fulness of our eternal marital relationship with Him in His Father's mansions. Jesus "prepared a place for (us)" (John 14:2) by shedding His blood to cleanse His bride of all sin so she can enter God's holy heaven.

In the meantime, may we as His holy bride remain spiritually "chaste virgins", faithful to our beloved groom until He returns to receive us to Himself.
