*Thus says the Lord: “Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; then you will find rest for your souls. But they said, ‘We will not walk in it.’ **Jeremiah 6:16***

## True Humility

**Matthew 24:14-30**

In **Philippians 2:1-4**, Paul commands Christians to exercise an attitude of humility toward one another. This command is followed by the only example of true humility in the attitude of the Lord Jesus Himself, which Paul describes in **vv. 6-11**. It is believed by many scholars that this section of scripture was used as a hymn by the early church.

Jesus became the epitome of humility when He willingly left His position of equality with His Father to come into this world of sin as a lowly servant. Jesus did not cease being God when He left His exalted position in heaven. Jesus left His high and holy position of equality with His Father, that He might come into this dark world of sin as God in the Flesh to do the will of His Father. His perfect life qualified Him to be God's perfect sacrifice for our sins as the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

Jesus is our perfect example of humbling Himself to do the will of His Father in heaven. Jesus is the only example of "true humility" because He, as Almighty God in heaven, left His exalted position of equality with God to live a humble, obedient life on earth as the perfect Son of Man.

Paul commands Christians to adopt the same attitude of humility that Jesus had. Someone wisely said "First comes the cross and then comes the crown." We obey the Gospel by being buried into Christ's death and raised to a new life of faith. We continue to obey the Gospel by counting ourself crucified with Christ (**Romans 6:11**), so that we will one day be exalted with Him to live in the new heavens and the new earth (**Isaiah 65:17**).
