"Danger! Danger!"

But I am afraid that just as Eve was deceived by the serpent's cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere and pure devotion to Christ. For if someone comes to you and preaches a Jesus other than the Jesus we preached, or if you receive a different spirit from the Spirit you received, or a different gospel from the one you accepted, you put up with it easily enough. – 2 Corinthians 11:3-4 NIV

Can we recognize when someone is teaching the truth or is teaching what is false about Jesus? Do we have the knowledge and spiritual discernment to recognize when someone is teaching error about the Holy Spirit? Paul is challenging the Corinthians – and us as well – not to be so gullible as to accept perversions of truth. Some of these false teachings sound nice, but underneath we find distortions of the nature of Jesus and the work of God's Holy Spirit. So, let's ask God to use the Holy Spirit in our lives to tune our hearts to know the truth about both Jesus and the Spirit. Let's go back and read [John 14-16](#) and let God's word remind us that the Holy Spirit is to help us in the quest to honor God's truth!

We read and talk a lot about God's love for us. His love is great because of His grace and His forgiveness. We must understand other qualities about Him also. We must look at His wisdom, His power, and yes, even His wrath to understand our heavenly Father.

“For the foolishness of God is wiser than man's wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than man's strength.” (1 Cor. 1:25) Daniel said, in his praise to God, **“wisdom and power are his.”** (Dan. 2:20)

God loves His Son. He gave him all power and authority, and because of this great love, John the Baptist tells us, **“Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him.”** (John 3:36)

God's wrath is brought upon us by our disobedience or by our unwillingness to repent. Although God is kind and patient, we can bring His wrath upon us. **“But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against yourself for the day of God's wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed. God will give to each person according to what he has done.”** (Rom. 2:5-6)

When we understand God's wrath and know how to avoid it, we can begin to look toward His promises. **“His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him...through these he has given us his very great and precious promises.”** 2 Pet. 1:3-4 – then in verse 11, **“...and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom.”**
