I don't know about you, but if it isn't any more permanent than that, it's not very real. I want something to hang on to. That requires I look past the seen to find my Father who is unseen. He is the one who guarantees the unseen!

Like Dew From The Lord

Micah predicted, “The remnant of Jacob will be among many peoples like dew from the Lord, like showers on vegetation which do not wait for man or delay for the sons of men” (Micah 5:7). Apparently, he was saying that a remnant of the Jews would be scattered among the Gentile nations, where they would bless their neighbors. The Jews were dispersed during the period between the Testaments (and afterwards), and they did bless the peoples among whom they lived.

Micah’s prediction provides a challenge for Christians today. The followers of Christ are scattered throughout the world and dwell among those who are not in the family of God. As Christians, we are to be “in the world” but “not of the world” (John 17:11-16). Even though we are surrounded by sin, we must not participate in the sinful activities of the world (Rom. 12:2; James 1:27). We should do our best to win people to Christ, so that they can be transferred from the world into the kingdom of heaven (Col. 1:13, 14). Every Christian ought to be a blessing to others (See Philemon 7).

In Micah’s words, we should be “like dew from the Lord,” refreshing the land. Jesus said we are to be “salt” and “light” (Mt. 5:13-16), making the world a better, happier, brighter place to live. When we as Christians bless the lives of our neighbors, they are likely to respond to the message about Christ.
