The Spirit of Love (1 John 3:11-18) Reflections – Omnipotence of Christ

Jesus’ parting words to His chosen apostles before His ascension were: ***All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth*** (Matt. 28:18). Christ declared that His authority (power) is unlimited! The theological word for God’s “unlimited power” is “omnipotence”. Jesus’ chosen apostles had been recent eyewitnesses to His power as He overcame man’s greatest enemy (death) by rising from the dead on the 3rd day after Satan’s temporary victory over Him in His crucifixion. Jesus’ death and resurrection fulfilled God’s first prophecy following man’s sin in Eden (Gen. 3:15).

During the three years of His earthly ministry, the apostles witnessed Jesus’ awesome signs and wonders which proved He was literally “Immanuel God with us in the flesh” (cf. Matt. 1:23). Jesus’ promise that all authority had been given to Him, assured the apostles that Jesus would empower them to do everything they needed to accomplish His mission of going into all the world to preach the gospel to every creature. Of course, we do not possess the miraculous power of the apostles. However, all disciples must fully trust daily in being “**strong in the Lord and in the power of His might**” (Eph. 6:10).

Jesus has the power to work in the feeblest of His servants and He even uses our weaknesses to carry out His purposes. Jesus has power over our every enemy, difficulty and danger. Jesus said to the apostle Paul: **2 Cor. 12:9**, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” In view of Jesus’ promise, Paul added: **Therefore, most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.**

Christ never gives us His power that we might regard it as our own. However, it is only as He indwells us to work in our hearts and lives that His power can help us overcome Satan’s world of lusts and pride. Without Jesus we can do nothing (**John 15:5**). Because of the omnipotence of our Lord Jesus, we can all confidently say: **I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Phil. 4:13).**
