SUFFERING FOR CHRIST

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, “Abba, Father.” The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God’s children. Now if we are children, then we are heirs – heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. **Romans 8: 14-17**

In **Romans 8: 14-17**, Paul talked about our being children of God. He climaxed his thoughts like this: “We are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ” (**Rom. 8:16b, 17a**). Being heirs of God is an exciting prospect – but we are brought back to the here-and-now by Paul’s next words: “If indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him (**Rom. 8:17b**; emphasis added).

Some religious groups deny the reality of suffering, while others insist that Christians need never suffer. On the contrary, the Bible teaches that suffering has been an inescapable part of life since Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit. A Christian is subject to all the problems that plague mankind, plus those he suffers for the name of Jesus (**1 Pet.**

4:16). Christ told His disciples, "If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you" (John 15:20). For some, suffering with Christ will mean death. For many, it will mean misunderstanding and misrepresentation. For all, it should include the burden of a world lost in sin (see Luke 19:10). Sooner or later, suffering is an inevitable part of trying to live for Jesus (2 Tim. 3:12).

When we suffer, what will keep us going? One important factor is hope. After Paul said, "If indeed we suffer with Him," he added, "so that we may also be glorified with Him" (Rom. 8:17b; emphasis added).

One of the great blessings about this presence is that God pours love into our hearts through the Spirit (Romans 5:5). Along with the great example of God's love in sending Jesus (John 3:16-17), the Father uses the Spirit to teach us how to love each other (Galatians 5:22-23). We are to be filled with the Spirit as we submit to one another (Ephesians 5:17-21). We share in the fellowship of the Spirit as fellow believers (2 Corinthians 13:14). We live together in unity and pursue peace as the Spirit transforms us to be ever more like Christ (Ephesians 4:3-4). Loving each other is not only a command; it is also part of God's continuing work in us through the Holy Spirit.
