Reflections – The Omnipresence of Christ

In addition to omnipotence, man’s second major thought of God is that He is unlimited in His presence. We are challenged to believe in what theology calls the “Omnipresence of God.”

Upon leaving His position of equality with God, Jesus humbly submitted to the Father and limited His presence to a temporal physical body on earth for 33 years as “the Son of Man.” The last three years of His life were devoted to His personal ministry among men.

Jesus officially launched His ministry with His baptism by John in the Jordan River. The Bible declares that upon His being raised from the waters of baptism, heaven above was opened, the Spirit of God descended in bodily form UPON HIM (key words) and a voice came from heaven which said **You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased (Luke 3:21-22).**

In the Old Testament when the Holy Spirit came upon someone, miraculous powers always followed. Following His resurrection, Jesus’ chosen apostles were instructed to wait in the city of Jerusalem until the power of the Holy Spirit came upon them to equip them to be His witnesses (**Acts 1:8**). After Jesus’ baptism by John, He began to perform miraculous works that proved He was God’s only begotten Son in the flesh (**John 5:36**). The fact that He began His miraculous works only after

His baptism at 30 years old, may account for the fact that even His own siblings did not believe in Him until He was miraculously raised from the dead. Jesus was treated by His siblings as just another son of Joseph and Mary. They did not regard Him as the miraculously conceived "Son of God."

On the night of His betrayal, Jesus began to prepare His chosen apostles for His departure. He assured them in [John 16:7](#); Nevertheless, I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. As long as Jesus was in His temporal body, it was impossible for Him to be with each of them at the same time. However, when He returned to the Father, He sent His "omnipresent Spirit" to be with each of His disciples at the same time. Thus, it was to their advantage that Jesus return to His spiritual existence that He might send His Spirit to be with them. His parting promise was; **lo I am with you always even to the end of the age. Amen. (Matt. 28:20).**
