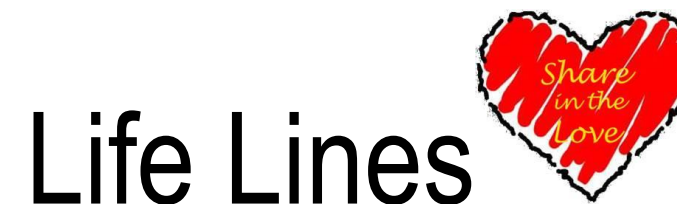

Our Burial In The Present

Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

Romans 6:3, 4

Let us now think of our burial, not the burial of those who die physically, but to our burial with Christ in baptism. The New Testament emphasizes the relationship between baptism and Christ's sacrifice (**Rom. 6:3, 4; Col. 2:12**).

It is to be a loving act. If we love Jesus, we will obey His command to be baptized (**Jn. 14:15**).

It is a courageous act. The decision to be baptized takes courage, sometimes a great deal of courage.

It is a necessary act. The Bible teaches that baptism is an essential part of our obeying the Lord and receiving the blessings of salvation (**Mk. 16:15, 16; Acts 2:38; Gal. 3:26, 27**).

It is an appropriate act. Even as we are to take up the cross of Jesus (see **Mt. 16:24**), we should also be “buried with Him” (**Rom. 6:4**). It is also appropriate for us to experience an actual burial in the water (an immersion), not a superficial sprinkling of water on the head.

It is an expectant act. Our burial in water is just step two. Step three is to arise from that watery grave to “walk in newness of life” (**Rom. 6:4**). If we lead the Christian life, then we have the thrilling expectation that the burial of our bodies in the earth will not be the end. Someday, we, too, will be raised from the dead (**1 Cor. 15:20, 23**)!
