The Great Sustainer

When he thunders, the waters in the heavens roar; he makes clouds rise from the ends of the earth. He sends lightning with the rain and brings out the wind from his storehouses.
Jeremiah 10:13

Jeremiah affirmed in verse 13 that God’s activity is never suspended nor is His presence ever withdrawn. The activity of the elements, the roar of thunder, the flash of lightning, the gentle fall of raindrops, the rush of the stormy wind, and the change of the seasons are but echoes of the eternal truth that Jesus calmly stated: “My Father is working until now, and I Myself am working” ([John 5:17](#)). Truly, as Paul wrote of Christ in [Colossians 1:17](#), “in Him all things hold together.” The writer of Hebrews said that Jesus “sustains all things by his powerful word” ([Heb. 1:3; NRSV](#)).

It is God who keeps order in the planets and the stars. It is His gravity that keeps us on earth. The lightning still flashes His glory, and terrifying are the arrows of Almighty God, as multiplied in His ingenious quiver of the ages.

Should a skeptic still seek to deny or ignore God’s greatness and grandeur, perhaps we should respond as God did to Job’s skepticism, by asking forty-six pertinent questions ([Job 38-40](#)). If God was not the source of the earth, who created it? Who prepared the air we daily breathe? Who holds the lever of

gravity in his hand? Who keeps us from flying off into space? Who maneuvers night into day, spring into summer, and puts mighty power in little seeds that become giant oaks? Let skeptics identify with facts the source of these daily evidences of mighty energy, power, intelligence, control, and law, if they deny God's claim (**Ps. 14:1-3**).
