I look behind me and you're there, then up ahead and you're there, too – your reassuring presence, coming and going. This is too much, too wonderful – I can't take it all in! Is there any place I can go to avoid your Spirit? to be out of your sight? If I climb to the sky, you're there! If I go underground, you're there! If I flew on morning's wings to the far western horizon, you'd find me in a minute – you're already there waiting!

[Psalm 139](#) has long been one of my favorite psalms. David gives us words to talk about God's abiding presence across every nanosecond of life. He is there at conception, knowing us, purposing our lives, and making us – his fingerprints are on us. He is there in the daytime and nighttime. He is there in good times and bad. He is there even as death surrounds us. And the means of his presence? The Holy Spirit. We cannot, and should not, ever want to be out of sight of God's Spirit or out of range of God's grace. How can we understand this concept? I don't think we are intended to understand it completely. We are to take comfort in it, as Jesus reminds us so powerfully in John chapters 14-16 when he calls the Holy Spirit our Comforter/Counselor/Advocate ([John 14:26](#); [John 15:26](#)). We join with David and say, "This is too much, too wonderful – I can't take it all in!"

A Beautiful Benediction

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work. – *2 Thessalonians 2:16-17*

Paul closed his discussion of the man of sin by pronouncing a beautiful benediction upon the faithful Thessalonians.

“May you have eternal comfort.” He wanted them to have a comfort that transcends this life and brings them into eternity. Wishing for others to have physical comfort is one thing, but wishing that they might have eternal comfort is another. May we wish our brethren eternal comfort.

“May you have good hope through grace.” He wanted them to have hope that is based in the grace of God. This hope is real and living, not dead and lifeless. May we wish our brethren the hope that comes through grace.

“May you be established in all good work and good words.” He wanted them to be firmly planted in good works and good speech, to live right and talk right. He prayed that Christ would control their deeds and their speech. May we wish our brethren to be established in all good works and good words.

This wish, as you can see, would result in the highest type of Christian living. Paul expressed the highest and best growth that every Christian ought to come to know. What do you wish for your loved ones in Christ?
