“How To Increase Our Joy”
Philippians 1:3-11
Being Filled with Christ

Picture in your mind’s eye two Coke cans side by side. On the surface they look the same, but there is a big difference. You can crush one of them easily because it’s empty; because there’s no INTERNAL pressure to resist the OUTWARD pressure, it easily collapses.

This empty can represent a person who is empty and is living without Jesus in his life. When tough times come, he is crushed by the pressures of this world. He may claim to be a Christian, but there is nothing on the inside. He may advertise the name, but there is nothing on the inside to live up to the name on the outside.

If we try to crush the opposite can, we can’t. Why? It is full of something. Because it’s full of the refreshing drink on the inside; it can withstand external pressure. The drink on the inside not only equals the external pressure, but it even exceeds it! We could prove that it is full if we shake up the can and pop the top, but we know what will happen if we do so.

Let this full can represent a person who is **full** of the life of Jesus Christ. The internal support Jesus gives through His Spirit is always stronger than the external pressures of the sinful spirit of this world. The Bible says to Christians: **the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world (1 John 4:4)**. Jesus promised: **In this world, you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world (John 16:33)**. We can rejoice in the Lord, because we may get knocked down, but by the powerful presence of Christ living in us, we'll never be knocked out!
