Lifelines by Patty McAlister

“I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content.” (Phil. 4:11, 12)

Most of us are always wanting something. We never seem to be satisfied with the way things are, or the things we have. Being content is easier for some than others. Happy people seem to be more content, but was Paul happy? We know that later he was.

Notice what Paul says in the two verses in Philippians. Both say that he had **learned** to be content. Contentment didn't just happen, he learned it. Paul didn't learn it because good things kept happening to him. Quite the reverse. Paul was in some kind of trouble every time he turned around.

Did Paul have this contentment while he was persecuting Christians? Did he learn it later, after his revelation on the road to Damascus? After this, he began to work for Jesus, not against Him. His purpose in life had made a drastic change. Many did not trust him.

Remember, Paul said that he had learned the **secret** of being content! Secret. How can we find the secret as Paul did? He later told Timothy, **“but godliness with contentment is great gain.” (1 Tim. 6:6)**

I'm sure Paul had learned contentment because his life was headed in the right direction. We would do well to learn for the same reason.
