Obedience of Love

Some Christians tend to negatively classify obedience as “legalism.” This is Satan’s ploy to sour our attitude toward what should be one of the great joys of the Christian life! The psalmist declared: I delight to do Your will, O my God, and Your law is within my heart (**Psa. 40:8**). Our greatest “delight” (joy) in life should be to love our Lord Jesus by faithfully keeping His commandments. Jesus said: He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him (**John 14:21**). Obedience is not “legalism”, obedience is “love”, and there is no greater joy in this world than to know God’s love and peace in our hearts!

The psalmist declared: and Your law is within my heart. What (or more accurately Who) is God’s law? Jesus is God’s law, for He is God’s Word (**John 1:1**) and God’s truth (**John 14:6**). When we trust and obey, He promises that the Father will love us and will manifest (reveal) Himself to us. What greater promise is there? Jesus is the pure source of all love, joy and peace! If we want God to make His home in us, we must yield our lives to Him and from a heart of love (as the old song declares) “trust and obey, for there’s no other way to be happy in Jesus, but to trust and obey.”

The above thoughts may raise the question: If “obedience is love”, what is legalism? Legalism is trusting our obedience to make us right with God. Legalism is ungodly, for it takes the focus off “Jesus” to place it on “self”. Anyone who trusts his own good works of righteousness to make him right with God is by definition a “legalist.” Anyone who trusts Jesus and obeys Him from a heart of love will find great delight in doing His blessed will!

What good would it do to consult a medical doctor, if one is not willing to follow his instructions? It would be a waste of time and money. What good does it do to call the Great Physician “Lord, Lord” if one is not willing to obey Him? Such is a total contradiction of terms! If Jesus is “Lord”, we must yield ourselves to Him in obedience. In yielding and obeying Him, we will find our greatest love, joy and peace in this life! Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who trusts Him ([Psa. 34:8](#)).
