“Living Above Our Circumstances” Jesus as the Alpha and the Omega (**Rev. 21:6**)

Alpha and Omega are the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet. When these two names are combined, they comprise a name for God. The name “the first and the last” appears in multiple places in the Old Testament as a representation for God’s eternal existence (see **Isa. 41:4; 44:6; 48:12**). God is the Alpha and the Omega because He is responsible for both the beginning and end of everything that has ever existed. Jesus had no beginning; He was present for the creation of the world (**John 1:3**), and He will be present for the end of the world (**Rev. 21:6**).

Jesus is the beginning and the end in many ways. **Hebrews 12:2** says that he is the “founder and perfecter” of faith, which signifies that He initiated faith and He will bring it to completion. He is the actual Word of God (**John 1:1, 14**); He is the fulfillment of the Law (**Mt. 5:17**); and He is the beginning of the gospel of grace through faith (**Eph. 2:8-9**). Jesus is there in the first verse of Genesis and the last verse of Revelation, and He is present in every Bible verse, story, and teaching in between. To say that Jesus is the Alpha and the Omega is to say that He is God, a declaration that is reinforced as true in the Gospels and throughout the entire New Testament.

The book of Revelation never wavers from proclaiming that Jesus and God are one, and that together they bring about the creation and culmination of everything. The Bible paints an amazing picture of how everything began and how everything will end. The best part about the beginning, the end, and everything in between, is that Jesus is the backbone, the central thread, the main theme, and the summation of it all. Not a single second in history has or will escape God's watchful eye; there is no part of the story where Jesus was not, is not, or will not be present and perfectly sovereign. That is the hopeful message of God's Word, His revelation to all who will believe.

Believers can be confident that the God they trust in is fully in control of everything that was, everything that is, and everything that will be. The name "the Alpha and the Omega" defines who God is and what He has done. From the beginning and to the end, God is eternal, God is in control, God is gracious and loving, God is just, and in the end GOD WINS.
