**Romans 3:21-26** features three great words at the heart of God’s plan for saving mankind: “justification,” “redemption,” and “propitiation.” These are difficult theological concepts, especially those related to propitiation. Is it necessary for us to understand such matters fully in order to be saved? No more than it is necessary for me to understand exactly how a lock works to get in my front door. The “key” to your salvation is to understand that Jesus died for your sins, and to trust in Him and His sacrifice. If you have not yet given your life to Him, I pray that you will believe and submit to the Lord (**Acts 2:36-38, 41, 47**). Can we imagine anyone in his right mind turning down the great gift of salvation?
