“Inner Peace”

During the Pandemic, many people have become so caught up in worry that they suffer from a lack of inner peace. Such anxiety should never be true of any Christian who has Christ as his **Prince of Peace (Isa. 9:6)**. Through Christ’s redeeming blood, we have **peace with God (Rom. 5:1)**. Having true peace of heart with God simplifies having peace with all others.

In Philippians Paul commands Christians who have made peace with **God to rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice (Phil. 4:4)**. Peace with God gives us the power to make up our minds to rejoice.

True peace is a mental state of mind and not based upon circumstances. Circumstances change from day to day and even from hour to hour. Since Jesus is the Rock of Ages who never changes, we can always rejoice in the Lord who saves us from all present and future anxiety.

Another key to experiencing peace of heart is unselfishness. It is human nature to be selfish, but Paul commands: **Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for**

the interests of others (Phil. 2:3-4). Selfish people are so wrapped up in themselves that they devote all their attention to self. Personal observation alone assures us that the most selfish are the most miserable people in the world. Those who focus on Jesus first, Others second and Yourself last will have JOY in their lives. Rather than worrying about the circumstances of our global pandemic, let's rejoice in our peace with God and focus our attention upon helping others with their troubles. We will worry less and rejoice more!
