A Beautiful Benediction

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work. – 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17

Paul closed his discussion of the man of sin by pronouncing a beautiful benediction upon the faithful Thessalonians.

“May you have eternal comfort.” He wanted them to have a comfort that transcends this life and brings them into eternity. Wishing for others to have physical comfort is one thing, but wishing that they might have eternal comfort is another. May we wish our brethren eternal comfort.

“May you have good hope through grace.” He wanted them to have hope that is based in the grace of God. This hope is real and living, not dead and lifeless. May we wish our brethren the hope that comes through grace.

“May you be established in all good work and good words.” He wanted them to be firmly planted in good

works and good speech, to live right and talk right. He prayed that Christ would control their deeds and their speech. May we wish our brethren to be established in all good works and good words.

This wish, as you can see, would result in the highest type of Christian living. Paul expressed the highest and best growth that every Christian ought to come to know. What do you wish for your loved ones in Christ?

"Where can I go to find God?" Mortals have asked this question ever since they were driven from the garden and from their daily walks with God in "the cool of the day" ([Genesis 3:8-24](#)). Nations have had wars over this question. Families have been split over this question. People have spent countless amounts of money to go on pilgrimages to answer this question. However, in this one passage, Paul reminds us of an inestimable grace: God lives in his people. Jesus had promised that where two or three are gathered together in his name, he would join them ([Matthew 18:20](#)), but we sometimes forget it. God chooses to come and live among people who offer themselves to him as followers of Jesus. That makes each Christian ([1 Corinthians 6:19](#)) and each congregation of Jesus' people ([1 Corinthians 3:16-17](#)) a sacred place where God dwells — no matter how large or small the group is or where it meets.
