"Too Deep for Words"

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.

Romans 8:26 ESV

Nearly all of us have been at this desperate place. Our souls are brittle and dry. All our prayers seem to bounce off the ceiling. They fall lifelessly to the ground and come to rest at our feet as bitter reminders of our failure and spiritual impotence.

Like every other great blessing from God, prayer has its origin and power in the Father's grace. Thankfully, the power of our prayers is not dependent upon our feelings, our perceptions, or our choice of words. The power of our prayer's rests in the hands of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit — as the Helper, Advocate, and Comforter — intercedes for us with our Father. Our Comforter articulates what we cannot say and captures the emotions we cannot verbalize. Our Advocate takes our prayers before the Father after his work of perfecting our words and emotions. He then intercedes for us according to the Father's will. Prayer, then, is not just a spiritual discipline, but also an incredible gift of our Father's grace. The Spirit assures us that we will always be heard and that our deepest longings will always be understood by the Father who loves us and always longs to hear the cry of our hearts.

ACTS 25:23, 24

King Agrippa and Bernice, along with the notable leaders of Caesarea and the Roman army commanders, entered into the auditorium. They came with great pomp and pride to hear from an accused apostle of Jesus. When they had taken their places, Governor Festus introduced them to Paul.

We should not feel sorry for the apostle. It was he, not those, in the distinguished audience, who dominated the scene. It was he, not they, who was the "Very Important Person" of that occasion. It is he, not they, whose name has become a household word. Someone has said, "Wouldn't they be surprised to learn that the only reason we have heard of them is because, on that day, their lives intersected with a prisoner name Paul?"

Never be jealous of the lifestyles of the rich and famous (see [Mark 10:42-44](#)). Outward grandeur is fleeting; "the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life" are "passing away." In contrast, "the one who does the will of God lives forever" ([1 John 2:16, 17](#)). We are reminded of Moses, who "refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin" ([Hebrews 11:24, 25](#)).
