The Problem of Self (John 3:30) **John’s Picture of Jesus**

The book of Revelation paints the most complete portrait of Jesus in His glorified state in heaven. God gives a special blessing to those who read and hear the words of this prophecy (**Rev. 1:3**). What a shame that so many Christians tend to shun this key book of the Bible because it is so “different.”

In **Revelation 1:5** John gave three key descriptions of Jesus. Jesus is “**the faithful witness**” as God’s special prophet from heaven who bore witness to God’s truth even to the point of death (**Luke 22:42**). Jesus also encourages His followers to be faithful unto death (**Rev. 2:10**). Jesus is “**the first born from the dead**” as He overcame death by His own power (**John 2:19**). He is the only person to die and be raised from the dead never to die again. This is the believers’ assurance that the righteous dead will also one day be raised with new spiritual bodies never to die again (**1 Cor. 15**). Finally, Jesus is “**the ruler over the kings of the earth**” because He is the only one to whom God gave the throne of David forever (**Luke 1:31-32**).

The Jesus Bible’s commentary on **Revelation 1:4-20** says; “After establishing Jesus’ elevated position, John wrote a vivid

description of the exalted Jesus. John observed that the only 'like a son of Man' wears a robe and sash ([Rev. 1:13](#)), which is similar to what a priest would typically wear ([Ex. 28:4](#)). His hair is 'white, like white wool, like snow' ([Rev. 1:14](#)), which is a symbol of wisdom and dignity ([Lev. 19:32; Prov. 16:31](#)). John described Jesus' voice as 'like the roar of many waters' ([Rev. 1:15](#)), a description also of God's voice ([Exek. 43:2](#)). Also, John depicts a 'sharp two-edged sword' ([Rev. 1:16](#)) coming out of his mouth, showing both how precise Jesus' Word is ([Heb. 4:12](#)) and that what he says is meant for judgment ([Matt. 10:34](#)).

John's incredibly vivid description of Jesus in the first chapter of Revelation sets the scene for the rest of the book. John started by confirming that Jesus is who He claimed to be during his earthly ministry ([Rev. 1:5](#)), and also confirmed that, when Jesus returns, it will be clear to all people that He is the Son of God ([Rev. 1:7](#)).
