## Encouraging One Another

*But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and brought us good news of your faith and love, and that you always have good remembrance of us, greatly desiring to us, as we also to see you – therefore, brethren, in all our affliction and distress we were comforted concerning you by your faith. For now we live, if you stand fast in the Lord. For what thanks can we render to God for you, for all the joy with which we rejoice for your sake before our God, night and day praying exceedingly that we may see your face and perfect what is lacking in your faith? – 1Thessalonians 3:6-10*

What kind of report did Timothy bring Paul (1 Thessalonians 3:6-10)? He brought a good report. Paul said he was comforted by their faithfulness. He said he would “really live” if they remain faithful to the Lord. Paul was praying night and day that he might see their faces once again.

When the gospel was brought to the Thessalonians, they were given a great gift. Now, it was time for the Thessalonians to do something meaningful for Paul. What could they do for the great apostle? What they did for Paul was what all Christians should do for each other. They encouraged him.

In what ways can we encourage one another?

**By remembering each other.** Paul had eagerly awaited word from Timothy about the status of the Thessalonian church. When Timothy came back, Paul was told that they remembered him always. They had him on their hearts. It is good to know that our brethren remember us.

**By longing to be together.** Paul was also told that the Thessalonians longed to see him. They had a deep yearning to be with him again.

**By standing firm in the Lord.** Paul said the thing that meant the most to him about the Thessalonians was that they stood firm in the Lord through the persecutions they were facing. He said this meant "life" to him.

Here is a simple formula for encouraging one another, especially when we are apart: Remember each other, long to be together, and stand firm in the Lord.
