*May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

***Romans 15:5-6***

Unity comes from God's Spirit as we follow Jesus. But unity has a purpose much deeper than our getting along with each other. Jesus prayed we would be one so that the world would know that God sent Jesus into the world as his Son ([John 17](#)). We want to be united so that our praise can bring glory to God. Unity is far more than a goal. Unity is a process through which the world learns of Jesus. At the same time, we glorify the Father who sent Jesus to save us. Leading others to Jesus and glorifying God are what living for Jesus is all about! Let's make unity our passion!

## What Now?

*Therefore, brethren, stand fast and hold the traditions which you were taught, whether by word or our epistle.*

*2 Thessalonians 2:15*

What were the Thessalonians to do now? They had withstood strong persecutions, grown in faith and love, and had come to a deeper understanding of the second coming. Now what? When we are well on our way in living the Christian life, what then do we do?

**Stand firm in the faith (v. 15).** They had believed the truth about Jesus and God, and they were to stand or remain in that belief. Their faith would hold them up if they would hold on to it.

**Stand firm in the truth.** They had been taught apostolic tradition by word and by letter (v. 15). In the New Testament, the word “tradition” (*paradosis*) is used sometimes of inspired writings and instruction, while other times it refers to the commandments of men (**Matthew 15:2, 3**). It means “something that is handed over.” It is used here of inspired writings. The Thessalonians had received inspired letters from Paul, and they were to read them and abide in his teachings.

Christianity is shallow enough for a child to wade in, but deep enough for an elephant to swim in. We have seen the simplicity of Christian living in this verse. Two steps have been enjoined: keeping the faith and staying with the faith.
