But you, dear friends, carefully build yourselves up in this most holy faith by praying in the Holy Spirit, staying right at the center of God's love, keeping your arms open and outstretched, ready for the mercy of our Master, Jesus Christ. This is the unending life, the real life! — [Jude 20-21 MESSAGE](#)

Prayer is a gift from God empowered by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit intercedes for us, and this intercession goes beyond our words ([Romans 8:26-27](#)). In **Proverbs 1:7**, Solomon tells us that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom or knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline. We are told to fear God and keep his commandments. This fear of God is a loving reverence for Him. Keeping his commandments is our whole duty.
