"All Glory to God!"

God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another. Do you have the gift of speaking? Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. Then everything you do will bring glory to God through Jesus Christ. All glory and power to him forever and ever! Amen. – 1 Peter 4:10 NLT

Why does God get the glory when we do what Peter commands in this passage? Because we do those things by God's powerful presence, the Holy Spirit living in us. We speak and we serve by the inspiration and power of the Spirit. The gifts that we are given come from the Holy Spirit — that's what the term "spiritual gifts" means. Jesus poured out the Holy Spirit on us when we came to him ([Titus 3:3-7](#)), and the Spirit gives each of us gifts to use in the body of Christ ([1 Corinthians 12:4-7](#)) and to help others ([Luke 10:25-37](#); [Galatians 6:10](#)). The glory belongs to God — Father, Son, and Spirit — because God is the source and the strength of all of the good that we do.

Christ Is All

Paul wrote in **Colossians 3:11**, “there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all and in all.” There is no greater truth when Christians are absolutely 100% dependent upon Jesus, for He is all that we need. The daily motto of every Christian should be “Christ is all!” We need to remember that “Christ is all” when we pray. We need to remember that “Christ is all” when we read His word, when we worship, when we venture out into the routine of our daily lives. We need to remember that “Christ is all” in our home life, in our business life, in our church life, in our recreational life and in all that we think, do and say.

Paul said that “Christ is all” using different vocabulary when he wrote, “For to me to live is Christ...” (**Phil. 1:21**). Can any of us imagine what would happen in our personal lives if we were to fully commit our hearts to living by the faith that “Christ is all”, and we believe with all of our hearts the promise that Jesus made to His disciples, “Lo I am with you always” (**Matt. 28:20**)?

Let me suggest to you, that if the church of Christ had more of Christ in our daily lives, we would grow so much spiritually stronger and would all be better prepared to live by the faith that when He is our all, we can know that He will be with us to give us personal access to the Father. When Christ is all, He will be all that I need to abide in His love and to have the assurance that He dwells in my heart. When that is my assurance of faith, my personal confidence will grow that because Christ is all, “I can do all things through Him Who strengthens me” (**Phil. 4:13**).
