"Nothing Else Matters!"

[Jesus said,] "The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you — they are full of the Spirit and life." — [John 6:63 NIV](#)

The apostle Paul said essentially the same thing as in today's verse when he wrote, "I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ and be found in him ..." ([Philippians 3:8-9](#)). Paul was saying that everything is nothing without Jesus. So much of what we pursue — what I have pursued — really counts for nothing. Economic meltdowns, which invariably happen, are reminders that the only investments that last, that are sure, are investments in Jesus and his kingdom. So we are called to turn our hearts to Jesus, to be shaped by his words, guided by his Spirit and conformed to his character. Jesus' words are lasting, eternal, and life-giving. Better yet, there is someone lasting and eternal and life-giving in his words — the Holy Spirit. That is why one of the ongoing works of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, is to bring to our minds the words of Jesus ([John 14:26](#)). So read the Gospels — Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. But more than reading the words, ask the Holy Spirit to be alive as you read and are shaped and given life through the words of the Savior!

Do you ever feel that in most of your prayers you are asking God for something? I do. I don't mean to, but it seems as if I am praying for help, for something, for the sick, for patience, for forgiveness, or for my family. And these are good things to pray for, but I feel selfish. Then I happened to read **James 5:13**. "Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray. Is anyone happy? Let him sing songs of praise." Right there in the Word of God, we are expected to pray when we are in trouble! How comforting! What we must do, though, is not to forget to praise God in our prayers. He answers our prayers, heals us and removes our troubles. We must have thankful hearts for what He does in our lives. (**1 Thess. 5:18**)

I think what I do and probably you do this too, is that we pray for something, later it comes about and we figure it "just happened." We don't realize that He answered our prayers. We are so independent!

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." (**Phil. 4:6**) Paul tells us to present our requests to God. Whatever troubles we find ourselves in, we should turn them over to Him. He expects us to, wants us to. He is our Father, and He wants to help. Then, He deserves our thanks and praise.
