Jesus’ Name “Wonderful”

*For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given. .
& His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor,
Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
Isaiah 9:6*

These prophetic words of Isaiah paint the most glorious picture of our Lord Jesus Christ that you will find in the entirety of God’s holy word! Each name of Jesus beckons our full attention and most careful meditation! I want to “Reflect” upon each of these powerful names that reveal Jesus’ full divinity as we “bow down before Him, love and adore Him”.

A hymn written in 1959 by Audrey Meir expresses the truth of Isaiah: “His Name is Wonderful: Jesus my Lord, He is the mighty King, Master of everything, His Name is Wonderful, Jesus my Lord. He’s the great Shepherd, the Rock of all Ages, Almighty God is He. Bow down before Him, Love and adore Him. His Name is Wonderful, Jesus my Lord.”

In the ancient past before “the beginning of time”, the precious name of Jesus was Wonderful, for John declared that all things were made through Him and without Him nothing was made that was made (**John. 1:3**). Such words are beyond comprehension as we meditate upon Him whose name is Wonderful, as He who existed before all things and was Creator of all things. How “Wonderful “that the very Creator was willing to humble Himself of His

position of equality with His Father in the highest heaven to come into this sinful world as the Child who was born and the Son who was given. The "Child who was born" declares His humanity as the Son of Man. The "Son who was given" declares His divinity as the Son of God for God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son (**John. 3:16**). The fact that Jesus was born as a Child into this world involved God's greatest miracle of the "incarnation" in which Divinity became humanity! My fellow brothers and sisters in Christ, let us join the angels in heaven to declare the Wonder of His name as He alone has been given the name "Wonderful" by the holy Father Himself who alone judged Him worthy of this high and holy name!

The name of Jesus remains Wonderful in "the present year of our Lord", 2020 A.D. In spite of the passing of some 2,000 years since His birth, His name has never grown old or common. How sad that possibly millions of souls on earth have never even heard that the name of our Lord Jesus is "Wonderful" for faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God (**Rom. 10:17**). Even those who have heard this name may fail to fully appreciate what it means! May we believers become more acquainted with it that we may more widely proclaim His awesome name to others!

Finally, let me say a word about Jesus' name in the future. At the time of His future coming in the glory of His angels, we will all finally see and fully know just how awesome Jesus' name Wonderful actually is! The Bible declares that one day the cry will echo: Behold the bridegroom comes! Arise and trim your lamps, and go out to meet Him. When we see Him coming, His Bride will be caught up in the clouds to meet Him with joy in the air because His name alone is Wonderful!
