## THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

*Our identity as God's children is defined by the presence of the Holy Spirit as we worship and continually offer ourselves as living sacrifices ([Romans 12:1](#)), not by our race or by a physical mark on our bodies. Those who have the Spirit are the children of God ([John 3:3-7](#)). We rely on the work of Christ and don't rely on our human attempts at significance. Christ poured the Spirit on us when we were saved by grace ([Titus 3:3-7](#)). The Holy Spirit is the mark of our identity ([Romans 8:9](#)). The work of the Spirit makes us a part of the body of Christ ([1 Corinthians 12:12-13](#)). The gift of the Holy Spirit is our gateway to authentic worship ([John 4:22-23](#)). The presence of the Holy Spirit makes us the dwelling place of God, a holy temple in which God lives through the Spirit ([1 Corinthians 6:19-20](#)). The presence of the Holy Spirit defines our lives in Christ and is crucial to our identity and worship! Rather than our lives and worship being tied down by all sorts of detailed rules like we find in the Torah, we are set free by the guidance of the Holy Spirit. ## Lifelines for Ladies by Patty McAlister

*Do you believe in God? Do you believe in His Word and that it is the truth? Do you believe there is a heaven? If you believe all of this, then you have to believe there is a hell?*

*Many people think God is all goodness and won't punish anyone. Doesn't He love every one? He does, but He also expects, and demands, that we obey Him. And the big thing is that God does not, and cannot lie. His word is the truth, inspired by the Holy Spirit!*

*"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Many will say to Me that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' He says, "The story concerns a conservative church official who died and ended up in the wrong place. Although this a fictional account, it is based upon scriptural inferences of the eternal punishment for the wicked. You will see eternity through different lenses. The journey will be disturbing and unsettling."*

*We have several copies and have been sharing it. He tells the truth, because those of us, who have read it, have been disturbed and unsettled. The author used vivid detail about hell, giving Scriptures for all of it. Are you doing the will of God as Jesus said we must do?*

*This person finds himself in everlasting hell, where the worm never dies. Every day he wants the torture to end but it doesn't.*

*Jesus said, "If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed, rather than having two hands, to go to hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched - where*

*"their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched." (Mark 9:43-44) and (Isaiah 66:24b)*

*At the end of the book the author says, "Ask yourself each and every day this one question, for it may be the most important question of your life: Where would you be if you died last night?" Search the Scriptures, find the truth. There is a heaven and there is a hell. Where do you want to spend eternity?*
