Though for the Week

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate [and reflect] the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. —
2 Corinthians 3:17-18

"I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh... But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law." Galatians 5:16,22, 23

Love: Paul said of faith, hope and love, these three; but the greatest of these is love. Love is of God. For God is love. (Corinthians 13:13; I John 4:7)

Joy: Rejoice always. It doesn't say to rejoice when we feel like it, or just when things are good. Rejoice in the Lord always. (Thessalonians 5:16; Philippians 4:4a)

Peace: The peace of God, which surpasses understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7) Through our faith in Christ we have this peace, knowing of the eternal hope we have of heaven.

Longsuffering: We glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance. Being fruitful in good works and increasing in the knowledge of God strengthens us with patience and longsuffering. (Romans 5:3; Colossians 1:10, 11) (We certainly want God to be longsuffering with us!)

Kindness: To grow in our spiritual life we must show kindness. Kindness shows love. Paul told us to be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as Christ forgave us. (Ephesians 4:32)

Goodness: God prepared us beforehand to do good works. We must do good works to be pleasing to God. He is good to us. God's goodness brings repentance. (Ephesians 2:10; Colossians 1:10; Romans 2:4b)

Faithfulness: Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Without faith it is impossible to please God. And a promise to us is; be faithful until death, and I will give you a crown of life. (Hebrews 11:1; 11:6; Romans 2:10b)

Gentleness: Let your gentleness be known to all men. To walk worthy of our calling we must go with lowliness and gentleness, bearing with one another in love. (Philippians 4:5a; Ephesians 4:1-2)

Self-control: To grow in faith and knowledge we must practice self-control. This means to practice patience, temperance, soundness and will power. The testing of our faith produces patience or self-control. (James 1:3)

If we have the love for God and for others, as we should have, all of these will be no problem. Faith, hope and love, these three; but the greatest is love!
