Reflections on Mounting Up with Wings Like Eagles (Isaiah 40:31)

The Lord created man's soul to soar in the spiritual heights of His love. God is love and we are made in His image for a relationship of love with Him. Those who love Him find the freedom to love themselves and others with His love. The more we love, the higher we soar in the spiritual heavens!

The prophet promised that those who "wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles". We must learn to trust and "wait on the Lord" because only He can pour His love into our hearts through His Holy Spirit (**Rom. 5:5**). When we repent and are buried by baptism with Christ into His death, our sins are all washed away by His blood as we receive the refreshing gift of God's Spirit of love (**Acts 2:38**).

The Christian life teaches us to trust and obey our Lord Jesus as we mature into His life of love. As spiritual eagles, we all have two wings, a wing of trust and a wing of obedience. Just as the eagle must use both wings to soar, we also must trust and obey if we plan to soar in the heavens of God's love. Some vigorously flap their wing of obedience & wonder why they fail to fly. Others try to flap their wing of faith while their wing of obedience remains hopelessly limp by their side. The Christian life is a life of faith in which we learn to "wait on the Lord" for His strength to obey Him through the love He shares

with us. Christianity is "faith working through love"-Gal. 5:6.

Those who soar with the Lord view life from a totally different perspective than captive "earth-bound eagles". The world of sin is ruled by Satan, the father of ill will & the source of all bitterness. Those who claim to love God but hate their brother are liars (1 Jn. 4:20). The faults of others loom as huge pillars when seen from an earthly perspective. When we soar in the high and heavenly places of God's love, joy and peace; His heavenly perspective allows us to view others' faults in the sunshine of His love. Our lives will be changed when we soar in the heavenly places to breathe in the fresh air of God's love, mercy and pity. The air and the view from heaven's perspective is so refreshing that we will want all to experience it as well!
