LIVING RIGHT IN A WORLD SO WRONG

For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 3:20

There is a hymnal we sing (not as often as we used to) title “This World Is Not My Home” it is a song of encouragement and a reminder that we do not live for this world. The first verse of the hymn says; “This world is not my home, I’m just a passing through. My treasures are laid up somewhere beyond the blue; The angels beckon me from heavens open door. And I can’t feel at home in this world anymore.” Sometimes we become so consumed in all that is going on in this world we live in, that we lose sight of this fundamental truth. And other times like the song says, “I can’t feel at home in this world anymore.” How do we live right in a world so wrong?

The answer is by faith, we do not lose faith. As the children of God, we have a faith that holds to a belief in the presence of God. We see the turmoil of this world, its constant struggle and some question, where is God in the midst of times such as these? Well, God is every present, this is a part of His divine nature. The Psalmist said; Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? (Psalms 139:7) To know that we are always in the presence of God assures us that our struggles, and sorrow, the dangers and temptations we face never go unseen or noticed by God. It should also place fear in the hearts of the wicked, their ungodly actions are not hidden from God. A God of judgment

and wrath. To believe in the presence of God then impacts the moral code of this world. Immoral people cannot produce morality! They have rejected the standard of morality that is within the heart of men and choose wickedness as their guide (Romans 1:18-21). By faith we believe in the providence of God, that He is in control and works all things to His purpose and glory. So, in this faith we do not live in fear "...For we know all things work together for good to those who love God..." we do not fear "tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword." For God will deliver! In faith we live and believe in the promises of God. We recognize the faithfulness of God, that "...no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ." (2 Corinthians 1:20 NIV) That it is impossible for God to lie (Hebrews 6:28 and Titus 1:20). In faith we hold fast to the hope that is in us, the hope of future glory in the resurrection, the hope we have of the future home that is being prepared for us in the Father's dwelling place. We have the same assurance of hope that Paul had when he said; Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing (2 Timothy 4:8).

So, as we journey through this life we recognize that this world is not our home. But we also know that while we do live here we live in the presence of God, that He is in control and we do not have to live in turmoil and fear. That we have a hope in the future glory to come and God is faithful to His promises. It is by this faith we overcome the world (1 John 5:4).
