By a Powerful Hand

The book of Exodus speaks of an event that intrigues me. In **Exodus 13:1-16** Moses makes a statement that leaps out at me. He said " *for by a powerful hand the LORD brought you out from this place*" (**Exodus 13:3**). It was Jehovah God who had brought the ten plagues upon the Egyptians and it was Jehovah God who slew the first born of both man and beast who did not have the mark of blood on their door posts. Moses was saying to the people that as you sanctify the first born child and the first born of your herds to the Lord remember who delivered you out of the hands of the Egyptians. As you celebrate the Feast of the Unleavened Bread each year remember who delivered you out of the land of bondage. As you do these things in the land that is flowing with milk and honey, the land that was promised to your fathers Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, remember who delivered you out of slavery. Remember " *for with a powerful hand the LORD brought you out from this place.*" Moses said these words while they were fleeing the Egyptians and before they crossed the Red Sea. He said these things with full confidence that God would deliver His people to that land they would call their own.

As we partake of the Lord's Supper on the first day of each week we are reminded that it was by the powerful hand of Jehovah God that we were delivered out of the bondage of sin. That He has set us free by the redemptive work of Christ at Calvary. That in our forgiveness, sin (as a representative of Satan) has been stripped of its power of condemnation. That no one, not even Satan the great

accuser can bring charge against Gods elect, for it is God who justifies.

It was by His powerful hand that He has made us to be a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, and a people for His own possession. It was by His powerful hand that He brought us out of the darkness and into His wonderful light (1 Peter 2:9, 10). It was Jehovah God who has made us a people when we were not a people, who has given us position and a place in His kingdom that will endure throughout eternity.

It will be by His powerful hand that one day we will be raised up in the resurrection and glorified in all eternity. To receive a body that is prepared for that spiritual realm, when mortality will put on immortality and the corruptible will put on incorruption. And in this glorified body we will dwell in the presence of God in His house, in the dwelling place He has prepared.

So, when we become consumed with the trials and tribulations of this life and we are sinking into the depths of despair let us remember that it is God who will deliver us with His powerful hand. No addiction can enslave you, no weakness can overcome you for God wants to and can deliver you out of slavery by the power of His mighty hand!
